SPECIAL NOTICES:

You are advised to read ALL the General Rules included with this schedule , but the following are major items requiring your attention.

1. This is an owner/agent multi ring in-cage vetted show with aisle benching. Your exhibits will therefore be **benched next to each other regardless of their show category.** (See items **18-22** in General Rules)
2. **CURTAIN SETS or their equivalent will be required for all exhibits' cages.** Cage Dimensions are: 62cm L x 48 cm D x 54 cm H.
3. You may enter the show by completing the entry form accompanying this SCHEDULE, or **ONLINE** at <http://catzinc.org.nz> Online entries must be paid for by **VISA or MASTERCARD.**
4. **TITLE QUALIFICATIONS.** Please read General Rules items **5,6,34,35,36 and 37.**
5. **DOMESTIC or COMPANION CAT EXHIBITORS** please pay additional attention to General Rules items **8,9, especially 13, and 14,16,25,26,34,35, 36 and 37.**
6. **NO exhibitor should exhibit a cat which, to their knowledge has had or been exposed to, any infectious disease or contagious parasitic infection within 21 days of the show.**
7. Exhibitors having a veterinary certificate providing clearance of any illness must present the original copy to the Show Manager at the commencement of the show. The exhibit in question will be thoroughly examined by the officiating veterinarian.

COMPANION CAT(Domestic) ENTRY ASSISTANCE:

City of Sails invites all exhibitors to partake of a "rations pack" which will contain provisions for lunch. These will be given out on your arrival at the venue Your Antarctic supply pack will include hot cups for soup and coffee and a voucher for a muffin and a freshly made sandwich.

Other items to consider:

1. Removal of your cats from the Show venue.

Exhibitors may leave the show and remove their cats from the venue after they have been judged in all rings AND the finals presented, provided that permission has been sought of the Show Manager in advance of leaving. Any cat which is not present when called for a final will be disqualified from that final and another cat called to replace it.

2. It pays to advertise! Please consider labeling your cage with a sign stating what Breed you are exhibiting. Show Rules allow for up to 500mm of static display to be on top of your benching cages. You may display photos, advertising, business cards, rosettes or certificates/wins from previous CATZ Inc shows.
